Dear Mr. Feldman,

As a follow up to our previous correspondence to you from Alexander Garvin, Vice President of Planning, Design & Development, I would like to thank you again for your proposal regarding the rebuilding efforts in and around the World Trade Center site. The development of a concept for this area is an important and difficult task that will take some time. We have received hundreds of compelling communications from architects, artists, and individuals regarding their thoughts about the tragic events of September 11 and their proposals for the site and elsewhere in Manhattan. We appreciate you sharing your ideas with us as we develop a process and a set of criteria for memorial proposals.

While we welcome unsolicited proposals, I ask that you return this letter to me within 21 days, with your original signature and the date of your signature, as indicated, signifying your agreement that (1) no compensation will be due to you in connection with your proposal, and (2) that you reserve no patent, trademark, copyright, trade secret, or other intellectual property rights in any of the material that forms or is contained in your proposal. When I receive your signed agreement, LMDC will maintain your proposal in a file that may be consulted as we develop the reconstruction concepts for the World Trade Center site and adjacent areas.

If I do not receive your signed agreement within 21 days, your proposal will be placed in the files of the Legal Department where no LMDC staff member or third persons will have access to it. (except as may be required by state or federal law) This latter action would not be a reflection of the merits of your proposal, but a procedure that has been established to protect the LMDC and its process.

Once again, thank you for your thoughtfulness and effort in sending us your proposal.
